

Electrical equipment in halls.

Students are permitted to bring the following UK purchased kitchen equipment to be used and stored in self-catered KITCHENS only, where the kitchen contains an oven and a hob. These appliances are not permitted to be stored or used in student bedrooms. **This equipment is not permitted in either Founder's or Reid catered hall pantries.**

Cooking equipment – permitted items	Comments
Coffee machine	To be used and stored in the kitchen only. Barista style machines that manually steam milk are not permitted.
Air fryer	To be used and stored in the kitchen only
Rice cooker	To be used and stored in the kitchen only
Kettle	To be used and stored in the kitchen only
Toaster	To be used and stored in the kitchen only
Iron	To be used and stored in the kitchen only
Personal grooming equipment – permitted items	
Curling tongs / straighteners	Must be PAT tested and have a BRITISH 3 pin plug. To be used with a heat resistant mat
Electric toothbrush	Must be PAT tested
Hairdryer	Must be PAT tested and have a BRITISH 3 pin plug.
Shavers	Must be PAT tested
Entertainment equipment – permitted items	
Docking station	Must be PAT tested and have a BRITISH 3 pin plug.
Laptop / phone charger	Must be PAT tested and have a BRITISH 3 pin plug.
Mobile phone	Used with a British standard lead and a BRITISH 3 pin plug.
PC / Tablet	Must be PAT tested and have a BRITISH 3 pin plug.
Printer	Must be PAT tested and have a BRITISH 3 pin plug.
Stereo / TV / Radio alarm clock devices / smart speakers	Must be PAT tested and have a BRITISH 3 pin plug.
Scanner	Must be PAT tested and have a BRITISH 3 pin plug.

Miscellaneous electrical items – permitted items	
Desk top fan / Desk lamp	Must be PAT tested and have a BRITISH 3 pin plug.
Fairy lights	Battery operated only
E-bikes	Permitted only when stored in designated bike sheds / enclosures. Not permitted at any time in building corridors or stairwells or in residential bedrooms or communal spaces.

Items prohibited from halls

The following appliances and equipment are not permitted at any time:

Prohibited items	Comments
BBO	Fire hazard
Blender / Food processor / Food mixer / Soda Stream	Fire hazard
Coffee grinder / Water boiler	Fire hazard
Candles / fire lighters	Fire hazard
Plate or bulb style mug, wax, candle or incense heaters of any description	Fire hazard
Plug in air freshener / electric blanket	Fire hazard
Deep fat fryer / electric frying pan	Fire hazard
Heating element / small ovens / radiant rings / microwave / hobs	Fire hazard
Panini press / Hot plate / Grill / Toasted sandwich maker / Slow cooker	Fire hazard
Refrigerator / Washing machine / Tumble dryer / Clothes heater / Dishwasher	Fire hazard
Lava lamps / freestanding lamps / plug in fairy lights or LED light strips	Fire and trip hazard
Cube adaptors / Non UK multi plug extension leads / Non UK fused adapters / Universal travel adaptor	Hazard
Portable electric heater / Dehumidifier	Fire Hazard. These will be supplied by the University in the event of a maintenance requirement.
Dehumidifier / diffuser	Hazard. These will be supplied by the University if required.
Nitrous oxide containers or cylinders / any other chemical accelerants or ignition sources such as batteries	Fire hazard. If found, a charge will be incurred by the residents for their disposal.

This list is not exhaustive and will be subject to change.

The use and presence of E-Scooters is prohibited across all areas of the Campus due to fire risks.

Under fire-safety rules, you are NOT permitted to burn candles, incense or otherwise-exposed naked flames, nor are you permitted to use electric fairy lights or plug-in diffusers anywhere within

Halls. LED strip lights must not be attached or stuck with adhesive pads to painted surfaces. Why not use non-electric reed diffusers and battery-operated fairy lights, or decorate your room with a house plant instead?

Residents found breaking these rules, may have to go through misconduct proceedings with the Hall Life team.
